FEMALE FOUNDERS: ENTREPRENEURIAL SPOTLIGHT



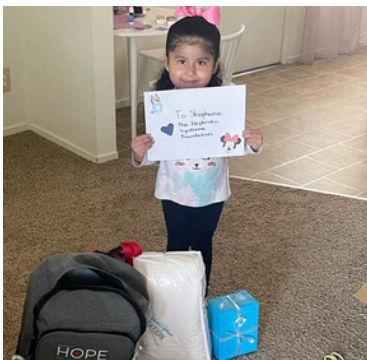
Andi Callaway is the Founder and President of The Nephrotic Syndrome Foundation (NSF), a California non-profit organization dedicated to families diagnosed with Nephrotic Syndrome. Inspired by their own journey after their son was diagnosed with the disease, in 2017 Andi and her husband Tucker, channeled their compassion and energy to create NSF with the hope no mother, father, or child should travel this journey alone.

Q: What is the journey that led you to start your own foundation?

A: Our son was diagnosed with Nephrotic Syndrome in 2012. All of a sudden we were navigating doctors and hospitals, administering chemotherapy and transplant medication, and trying to adapt to a new life. I realized if we were struggling, there must be others like us and soon, felt a calling. I knew what families needed, since I needed it too. I knew if I could tell our story, we could make a difference - not just for each family, but for all those to follow.

Q: What advice would you give to someone looking to start their own charity?

A: Do it! When it feels hard, or you are overwhelmed by how much there is 'to-do', remember you are bringing good into the world that wasn't there before! There is so much good in the world if you choose to see it, and 'purpose', if you are blessed enough to find it in this lifetime, is a beautiful gift.



Q: What is a success from the past year that you can share?

A: In October we surpassed 1,500 families served through our flagship Backpacks of Hope program! Each one is individually curated for newly diagnosed pediatric patients, containing medical supplies, educational information and comfort items. They are worth over \$350 each, and are a bright light for these warriors. On top of that we hosted Camp NSF, awarded over \$20,000 in financial support to patients, and delivered hospital-grade thermometers (worth \$400 each) to over 100 families.
